In-person services including access to computer equipment, employment support, and more are available at the Eastland office location by appointment only on Thursdays from 9:00am-3:00pm. All appointments must be scheduled in advance by visiting www.wfswct.org and clicking the red “Make An Appointment” button located along the right side of the screen or by calling the Eastland Workforce Center at (325) 795-4213. A full slate of virtual services to workers, employers, families, and child care providers remain available at www.wfswct.org such as live chat, job openings, virtual workshops, orientations, and how-to videos.
